ALL-STAR PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

All Parents are required to sign the following code of conduct in order for their athlete to participate in the 2025 All-Star Season.

As a parent or guardian of a child participating in the Simi Valley Girls Softball youth softball program, I understand that my actions have a significant impact on the experience of all players, coaches, officials, and spectators. I therefore agree to the following code of conduct:

Respect & Sportsmanship

1. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or team activity.
2. I will not engage in or tolerate yelling, taunting, or negative comments directed at players, coaches, officials, or other spectators.
3. I will applaud effort in both teams and promote the spirit of fair play.

Communication

4. I will communicate respectfully with coaches, avoiding discussions during games or practices. I will request a meeting at an appropriate time to address any concerns.
5. I will not criticize or question coaching decisions or player positions during games or practices.
6. I will not post negative comments on social media about players, coaches, officials, or the league.

Behavior Expectations

7. I will ensure my child arrives on time for games and practices, prepared to participate.
8. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players from the stands or sidelines.
9. I will never engage in physical or verbal altercations at any league event.

Accountability

10. I understand that failure to follow this code of conduct may result in disciplinary action, including but not limited to verbal warnings, removal from events, or suspension from team activities.
