ALL-STAR COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT

All coaches are required to sign the following code of conduct in order to coach the 2025 All-Star Season.

As a coach, you are a role model for your athletes and a representative of Simi Valley Girls Softball (SVGS). All coaches are expected to follow the highest standards of behavior, both on and off the field. This Zero Tolerance Code of Conduct outlines the expectations and the consequences of failure to adhere to these standards.

I understand that I am coaching a recreational All-Star softball team and acknowledge that positive development of the children I coach and sportsmanship is the highest priority.

I will educate myself and be knowledgeable in the rules of softball and I will teach these rules to my players.

I agree to honor and uphold the rules of SVGS and decisions of the SVGS board. I agree and understand that the umpire has final discretionary control over the game, and agree to refrain from dissent, verbal, and/or physical assaults.

I agree that I am responsible for, and will control myself, assistants, coaches, parents and spectators of the game from my team, and treat opposing coaches, player's umpires, and parents with courtesy and respect.

I understand that if I am ejected from a game by an umpire official, I will notify the All-Star Commissioner immediately and follow USA softball protocols. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action that is not limited to suspension of All-star team activities; that include: practices, and or games/tournament.

I agree and understand that my team will only wear the official All-Star uniform as determined by the SVGS board for all games.

I will communicate often and effectively with the players and parents. I will demand a sports environment that is free of drugs, tobacco/vape, alcohol, profanity, vulgar gestures, and will refrain from their use at all softball events.

I understand that I will be removed as a coach by the SVGS board for repeat violations of this code of conduct, or any rule of the league or tournaments.
